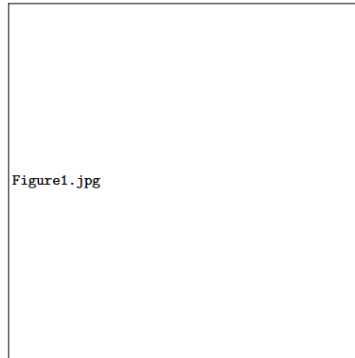


Figure 1: Caption of the figure.
